1. Getting Started

Subscribe

Subscribe is where you can create and manage your University email and computing account.

Multi-factor authentication (MFA)

Once you have created your account, you will need to set up multi-factor authentication (MFA). MFA will prompt you to confirm your identify when you sign in.

ID Card

All students and staff of the University of Southampton are issued with an ID Card, which they are required to carry while on University premises. Cards can be set up to provide access to specific areas. Where this is required check with your School or local contact for details of how to request access.

Global Protect (VPN) and Southampton Virtual Environment (SVE)

A VPN is establishing a private connection into the University network via your public internet connection. This is done from your own device. From here you can access specific network resources that are unavailable publicly, such as the HR system or Library journals.

SVE is a virtual desktop environment which aims to provide a consistent desktop experience from anywhere. This is a managed University desktop with specific software ready to go! This is ideal if you need a full desktop experience with access to a large software portfolio.

Printing

Computers managed by the University with a name like UOS-number (for example: UOS-1234567) and public work stations (computers in a teaching space), have printer queues automatically configured. Printers are called BlackWhite and Colour on staff.myprint.soton.ac.uk or student.myprint.soton.ac.uk.

Documents can be collected from any University printer. You will need to log in using your user name and password or by swiping your ID card.

Pure and ePrints

The University is committed to making research outputs openly accessible via its institutional repository at the earliest opportunity to maximise the visibility and impact of research, recognising that there will be instances where ethical or contractual restrictions apply.

Pure is the University of Southampton research information system used to manage research outputs. The University requires research outputs to be deposited in Pure, which are then uploaded to <u>ePrints</u> <u>Soton</u>, the University's Institutional Research Repository.

Pure is available to everyone with an honorary / visitors contract. Access is not automatic but can be requested when an honorary contract is set up.

Users need to be on campus to access Pure or logged in via a VPN or SVE.
